Where To Dump Your Junk?

It can be a tedious task determining where to properly dispose of the different kinds of waste that we generate on a day to day basis. Fortunately, there are many free and local resources available to help us manage our refuse environmentally and economically.

The Carroll County Solid Waste Authority and Madison County Solid Waste/Recycling Center are the two bodies that handle most refuse across the Kings River watershed. Both organizations have extensive recycling programs and will accept many hazardous products that don't belong in our groundwater including:

Automotive Products – motor oil, oil filters, brake and transmission fluid, antifreeze, batteries

Paint Products – oil-based and latex paints, stains, aerosol cans, paint thinners and strippers

Lawn and Garden Products – pesticides, herbicides, insecticides

Batteries – household batteries, motor batteries

Cleaning Products – any household cleaning product, including those with bleach and ammonia

Appliances – microwaves, dishwashers, dryers, ect. (appliances containing Freon may require a fee)

In addition to these products; tires (limited amounts for free), furniture, construction materials, and much more can be taken to the respective transfer stations in Carroll and Madison Counties.
